Things to do:

#### Step 1: Apply

- Apply for admission at <u>www.bhc.edu/apply</u>.
  - Pay \$20 application fee.
  - Look for your welcome letter in 1-2 business days at the email address you provided on the application.
- **Given Send official transcripts from your high school and/or previous college.**
- Send placement scores from another school or ACT/SAT test scores (taken within the last two years).
- Apply for financial aid at <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>. BHC's school code is 001638. FAFSA is available December 2023 for the following fall semester. Get more information at www.bhc.edu/financialaid.

#### Step 2: Log into myBlackHawk
